

Dear Cornerstone Family and Friends,

We wanted to give you the most recent updates regarding COVID-19 policies and our Lord's Day worship arrangements. Given the recent changes outlined from our local authorities, we are trying to return to normal as much as we can while still providing room for people who wish to remain more cautious. So as of this Sunday, June 7:

The main (middle) level of our building will be opened up for normal seating. This means that all pews will be available, and all pew Bibles and visitor cards will be returned. We are asking that everyone please sit on the main level so that we can use the upstairs and basement for other purposes.

If you or your family would like to secure a space where you can maintain more distance from other households, we ask that you sit upstairs in the balcony. The balcony will only be for those who wish to have more space or for overflow in case we run out of room on the main level.

As for the basement, we are requesting that this space be reserved for those who need to step out with their children or for more overflow in case we run out of room in the balcony and the main level. We are asking that people not sit in or use the basement unless it is needed.

Because we will be sharing in the Lord's Supper this Sunday, we want to let you know how we are handling this as well. If you sit on the main level, the bread and cup will be passed as normal. If you sit in the balcony, the usher(s) will take them to each row without passing the plates. So if you prefer to not take communion from the plates being passed, we ask that you sit upstairs.

Again, we want to thank everyone for how smooth this process has been. We have noticed a willingness for people to bend both ways in order to accommodate as many people as possible. This is a great testimony of your love for the Lord and one another.
